Reggae Math Foundation believes that low education & achievement can be transformed by *inspiring teachers*.

Reggae Math Foundation (RMF) is devoted to improving the math education for underserved students by making available online videos of classes from some of the top math teachers in Jamaica. It was founded in 2016.

Between 2001 and 2011, only 17% of graduating students in Jamaica passed the Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate (CSEC) high school math exam.

Currently, RMF is crowdsourcing to raise enough money to create 10 videos of educators with a knack for reaching students who are having difficulties. The cost is approximately \$5,000. If the organization can raise over \$5,000, they will continue to create additional videos adding great math teachers from outside of Jamaica.

"We want to see a better and brighter future for Jamaican kids, and we believe a solid foundation in math can help us out of the economic and social challenges we face," Dr. Bailey-McWeeney said.
