Michael Salmon is the President of the Knox Association of Past Students, New York Chapter and also serves as a Director on the board of UJAA. After teaching in the Department Economics at UWI, Mona, for several years, in 1985, Michael was the recipient of the prestigious LASPAU-Fulbright fellowship to pursue the doctorate degree in economics at New York University. In 1987, while continuing to pursue his post-graduate studies, Michael began his over thirty-five years teaching career at the University. In 1993, he was also invited to teach economics at Marymount Manhattan College, in New York, where today, in addition to his faculty role, he is an Associate Vice President, Dean of Academic Excellence and Senior Advisor to the President. As a member of the President's Cabinet, Dean Salmon also serves as the chair of the President's Taskforce on Equity, Diversity and Inclusion, and is the president's liaison to the Board of Trustees on related matters.
